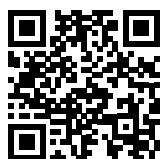
To Participate

- Must be a TMIST study participant
- Must agree to provide a one-time blood and/or cheek cell sample in the optional section of the TMIST consent form

Procedures

Blood and cheek cells will be collected by your local TMIST team at your enrollment visit or during one of your study screening mammography visits.

- A small tube of blood will be collected from a vein in your arm at your enrollment visit or during one of your study screening mammography visits.
- Cheek cells will be collected by rinsing your mouth with mouthwash or salt water and spitting into a large tube.
